



## **San Marino Tsunami's Monthly Dues Payment Policy**

Dear Team Parents,

All year-round members of the Tsunamis are required to pay a monthly fee of \$100 with each additional sibling entitled to a 10% discount. The fee is utilized to pay for pool rental and maintenance, coaching staff, and then the Coach. Payments are due on the 1st of the month, payable to the City of San Marino, Rec. Dept. and may be mailed or brought directly to the office at Stoneman School located at 1560 Pasqualito Drive, San Marino, CA 91108. Any payments received after the 5th of the month will be charged a late fee of \$25 by the City of San Marino.

Seasonal swimmers are those enrolling for the months of April 1 through August 30. The Seasonal rate is \$150 per month. Year-round swimmers will pay \$100 per month from September through August 30. Any new swimmers beginning during the Seasonal period must pay the Seasonal rate until August 30. If the swimmer continues in September, they will then pay the Year-round rate of \$100 per month.

Unpaid tuition beyond the 10th may jeopardize your child's ability to attend practices and participate in swim meets. This policy is required to ensure a proper roster count (which is imperative to your child's safety) and correct instructor payments, and is mandated in every monthly programming area in the Department.

Monthly dues will not be prorated for partial absences (e.g., due to illness, vacation, or finals). If your child takes a leave of absence from the Tsunamis for an entire month, or two months, etc. (as sometimes happens during the summer or High School swim season), monthly dues still need to be paid in full even if your child is not swimming.

In August the Tsunamis take approximately a 2 week break from practice. Full dues for August must still be paid to remain on the team; there is no pro-rating of dues for August, or during any breaks.

Please remember that your dues not only go to coaching your children, but also pay for equipment, pool rental and maintenance, and many other expenses that are on-going all year.
